- V. INTERCESSION FOR THE LOST
 - A. Parents and relatives
 - B. Friends

 - E. Authorities (government, personal)
 - F. Current Bible studies and contacts
- VI. MEMORY WORK
 - A. “Schema” – Deuteronomy 6:4-9
 - B. Weekly scripture goal
