

# The Gospel in Scripture

1. Mark 16:15—Command to preach the Gospel.
2. I Corinthians 15:1-8—God’s definition of the Gospel.
3. Galatians 1:6-9—Warning not to distort the Gospel.
4. Romans 1:16—The Gospel must be believed.
5. II Thessalonians 1:6-9, esp. verse 8—The Gospel must be obeyed.
6. Romans 6:1-4—How to obey the Gospel.
  
7. Jesus’ baptism (immersion)
  - a. Matthew 3:16-17—Outside view.
  - b. Luke 3:21-22—Inside view: “praying”.
  - c. Luke 11:13—Need to ask for the Holy Spirit.
8. Acts 2—First time the Gospel is preached.
  - a. Acts 2: 14—Peter preaches.
  - b. Acts 2:22-36—Peter preaches the Gospel.
  - c. Acts 2:37—Audience response.
  - d. Acts 2:38—Peter tells how to obey the Gospel.
9. Paul’s conversion.
  - a. Acts 22:1-16—Account by Paul himself.
  - b. Acts 9:9-11—Three days in Damascus, fits between Acts 22:11-12.
  
10. Mark 16:16
  - a. “Believed”—specifically the Gospel from Mark 16:15.
  - b. “Baptized”—Obey the Gospel: death, burial, resurrection, and appearance.
  - c. “Shall be saved”—Believe the Gospel and obey the Gospel = salvation.
